* This concerns concentrates sold as 'complete' feeds with added vitamins and minerals and a daily dosage, for example sport-, light muesli- or senior mixes. Roughage mixes or other supplementary feeds without these additions can certainly be offered alongside our Equilin® products, taking care to feed a full dosage of BALANCER or GROW.

** In the case of long-term vitamin and mineral deficiencies, the decision can be made to start feeding a BALANCER at this stage, combined with concentrates or a tasty mash.

*** We recommend feeding the high maintenance dose for at least 4 weeks after the build-up dose, and only then seeing how far this can be reduced with BASIC in small steps.

In a weight-loss or rehabilitation diet, calculate for the horse's target/normal weight. Since very poor roughage should be fed in this case, the BALANCER's can be fed at 120% of the daily dose.

Nutrition is always a highly individual affair. There is no such thing as 'one size fits all', and especially not when a large part of the diet consists of roughage with a lot of variables. The dosages mentioned above are guidelines, in case of any doubts please contact us for a nutritional advice; or read our book for more in-depth insights into the horse's daily nutritional needs.

SAMPLE RATIONS

PONY 300 KG | recreational work 3 x 1 hour a week

Start with an IMMUNO treatment or feed 250 g BASIC or COMFORT for the first 3 weeks. Gradually decrease the amount of concentrates over this time. With the maintenance dose of IMMUNO, 60% of the BALANCER may be fed.

- 5,5 kg average hay (> 80% dry matter)
- 350 g alfalfa, roughage mix or light muesli
- 70 g BALANCER
- 100 - 150 g BASIC
- 5 g salt
- 2 hours grazing in a fixed field



HORSE 500 KG | up to L/M level dressage

Start with an IMMUNO treatment or feed 350 g BASIC or COMFORT for the first 3 weeks. Gradually decrease the amount of concentrates over this time. With the maintenance dose of IMMUNO, 60% of the BALANCER may be fed.

- 8 kg average haylage (> 70% dry matter)
- 500 g alfalfa or roughage mix / 500 g muesli
- 100 g BALANCER
- 150 to 200 g BASIC
- 10 g salt and RECOVER when the horse has sweated heavily
- 4 hours of grazing



HORSE 550 KG | Z level dressage / M level jumping

Start with 3 weeks of 400 g BASIC, gradually reduce the concentrates over this time.

- 7,5 kg average haylage (> 70% dry matter)
- 1 kg alfalfa or roughage mix
- 1 kg sport muesli
- 50 to 80 g BALANCER
- 200 g BASIC
- 10 g salt and RECOVER when the horse has sweated heavily
- 3 hours of grazing



REHABILITATION

Start with an IMMUNO treatment or feed 350 g BASIC for the first 3 weeks. Gradually decrease the amount of concentrates over this time. With very temperamental animals, only start feeding the build-up dose when work can be recommenced.

- 10 kg **poor or sober** haylage (> 70% dry matter) or hay.
- 0,5 - 1 kg alfalfa or roughage mix
- 100 - 120 g BALANCER
- 100- 200 g BASIC or COMFORT



PREGNANT MARE 600 KG | 8 - 11TH MONTH OF GESTATION

After the birth of the foal, 50% of the advised mare feed can be added to the ration.

- 16 kg average haylage (> 70% dry matter)
- 1 kg alfalfa or roughage mix
- 0,5 - 1 kg mare feed
- 210 g GROW
- Optionally 150 g BASIC



Under dried roughage we classify the majority of biodiverse, well-dried roughage containing various grasses and herbs; if you want to do your horse's intestinal flora a real favour.

As extra and instead of the minimum of 1,5% of dry matter in the roughage, other low-energy, high-fiber products such as alfalfa, roughage mixes, bran, carrots, soaked beetroot mash or 'green' light muesli's or mashes can also be fed.

Always offer your horse a salt lick and add extra salt if very little or no concentrates are fed. In periods of increased workload, first look at feeding richer roughage instead of more concentrates.
